- They are an initiative of Harmony Foundation, an organization created by Dr. Abraham Mathai in Mumbai. It is the only award in the name of Mother Teresa reviewed & recognized by Sister Prema, Superior General — Missionaries of Charity
- Previous recipients of the award include Nobel laureates
 Malala Yousufzai, The Dalai Lama and Kailash Satyarthi.
