- It is 2655 km. gas pipeline project that will cater to the energy requirements of five states, namely Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and West Bengal.
- It is also known as Jagdishpur – Haldia & Bokaro – Dhamra Pipeline Project (JHBDPL)
- Aim: to have a gas based economy and to enhance the share of gas in the energy basket to 15%.
- The main trunk of the pipeline ends to Haldia (West Bengal) and Dhamra (Odisha).
- The project is being implemented by state-run gas utility
