About the Deucha Panchami coal block-

 The Deucha-Panchami-Dewanganj-Harinsingha coal block is the newest coal mine in the Birbhum district of West Bengal state.



- It is the second-largest coal block in the world and is the largest in India.
- The block has a thick coal seam trapped between equally thick layers of rocks, mostly basalt.
- The existence of these thick basalt layers, however, makes mining of coal difficult.
- More foreign investment and technology will be hence needed for mining.
- However, a total of 21,000 people will be displaced.
- India's abundant domestic reserves are in the states of Jharkhand, Odisha, West Bengal, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Telangana and Madhya Pradesh.
