INS Vikrant

<u>In news</u>— The Vice President of India visited India's first indigenous aircraft carrier, INS Vikrant in Kochi recently. <u>About INS Vikrant-</u>

- It is the 40,000-tonne aircraft carrier, the largest and most complex warship built in India.
- It is the first aircraft carrier to be built in India.
- It is 262 meters long, 62 meters wide and it has a height of 59 meters.
- Its construction began in 2009 and the warship has been built by Cochin Shipyard Limited(CSL).
- It has over 2,300 compartments, designed for a crew of around 1,700 people, including specialized cabins to accommodate women officers.
- Vikrant has a top speed of around 28 knots and a cruising speed of 18 knots with an endurance of about 7,500 nautical miles.
- It can operate MiG-29K fighter jets, Kamov-31 helicopters, and MH-60R multi-role helicopters.
- The ship, with a high degree of automation for machinery operation, ship navigation and survivability, has been designed to accommodate an assortment of fixed-wing and rotary aircraft.
- It is named 'Vikrant' as a tribute to India's first aircraft carrier, Vikrant (R11).
- It is scheduled to be commissioned into the Indian Navy in August 2022.

Indian Navy Ship Vikrant (R11) was a <u>Majestic-class aircraft</u> <u>carrier</u> of the <u>Indian Navy</u>. The ship was <u>laid down</u> as HMS <u>Hercules</u> for the British <u>Royal Navy</u> during <u>World War II</u>, but was put on hold when the war ended. India purchased the incomplete carrier in 1957, and construction was completed in 1961. Vikrant was <u>commissioned</u> as the first <u>aircraft carrier</u> of the Indian Navy and played a key role in enforcing the <u>naval blockade</u> of <u>East Pakistan</u> during the <u>Indo-Pakistani War</u> <u>of 1971</u>. It was <u>decommissioned</u> in January 1997 and was preserved as a <u>museum ship</u> in <u>Cuffe Parade</u>, <u>Mumbai</u> until 2012. The ship was <u>scrapped</u> in November 2014 after final clearance from the <u>Supreme Court</u>.

 India currently has only one aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya (It is a modified <u>Kiev-class</u> <u>aircraft</u> <u>carrier</u> and the flagship of the <u>Indian Navy</u>, which entered into service in 2013).
