- Component-1 will endeavour to identify the motivated young talents with research and innovation aptitude in universities and colleges.
- Component-2 will be mainly to enhance problem solving skills with help of social innovation and action research to improve well being of people and contribute for India's developing economy.
- Component-3 will fund high impact research projects in the identified thrust areas inhumanities and human

sciences through a national network of eminent scientists from leading institutions.
