## Tarantula Spider

April 7, 2020 Why in news?

- Genus can be identified based on the banding patterns on the underside of the legs.
- IUCN status Peacock Parachute Spider or Gooty Tarantula was spotted by a team of researchers in the Pakkamalai Reserve Forests near Gingee in Villupuram district of Tamilnadu.

## About it:

- The spider belongs to the genus Poecilotheria.
- It is endemic to India.
- Its **known habitat** is in degraded forests near Nandyal in Andhra Pradesh (**Eastern Ghats**).
- For the first time it has been sighted beyond its known habitat.
- Species of this Critically Endangered.
