About the plant

- The plant will produce electricity through bio-gasification of bio-degradable waste generated from the market
- Using the process of bio-gasification, the plant can convert organic waste weighing up to 15 tonnes into 1,500 units of electricity.
- The cost of managing and operating the plant for six years is Rs 1.11 crore.
