Theme for World Heritage Day 2021

- 'Complex Pasts: Diverse Futures' is the theme for World Heritage Day 2021.
- Every year, the International Council on Monuments and Sites makes a decision.
- ICOMOS encourages people of all religious backgrounds to put their differences aside and come together to spread the message of unity.

World Heritage Day 2021: History

- The Venice Charter, also known as the 1964 International Charter on the Conservation and Restoration of Monuments and Sites, laid the foundation for the ICOMOS organisation.
- The International Council of Mountains and Sights proposed celebrating World Heritage Day on April 18, 1982, during a seminar in Tunisia.
- Then, in November 1983, at the 22nd session of the UNESCO Conference, a resolution was passed declaring April 18 to be World Heritage Day every year.

World Heritage Sites in India

- At present, India has 38 World Heritage Properties.
- All the sites under the Ministry are conserved as per ASI's Conservation Policy and are in good shape.
