

Zero-Emission Vehicle Transition Council (ZEVTC)

In news- On Transport Day at COP26, India, represented by NITI Aayog, participated in the fourth ministerial dialogue of the ZEVTC.

About ZEVTC-

- **It is** a global forum on enhancing political cooperation on the transition to zero-emission vehicles.
- **The Council brings together ministers and representatives of some of the world's largest automobile markets** to collectively address key challenges in the transition to ZEVs, to enable faster, cheaper, and easier transition to EVs for all.
- Several stakeholders—automotive manufacturers, governments, businesses, fleet owners, etc.—made the declaration to actively work towards the proliferation and adoption of zero emission vehicles.

ZEVTC declaration-

- It was declared that all sales of new cars and vans being zero emission globally by 2040, and by no later than 2035 in leading markets.
- Automotive manufacturers also announced to work towards reaching 100% zero emission new car and van sales in leading markets by 2035 or earlier.
